Meeting called by the President at the Illinois Central Depot and all trustees present as follows. Atkins Lee Wright Herscher ^{Wright} and Easton. Minutes of last meeting read and accepted. President Atkins reported his having met with no success in consulting with Supervisor Berger relative to his deeding Pilot Center Cemetery from the Town over to this Association.

The following by-laws were then ^{read} and upon motions were accepted.

— By Laws —

Section One.

The name of this Association shall be the Pilot Center Cemetery Association of the Town of Pilot, County of Hancock, State of Illinois.

Section Two

The records of this Association shall

consist of all persons who now own, or shall hereafter purchase lots in the Cemetery grounds of this Association, and keep up, and maintain their assessment.

Section Three.

Each member shall be entitled to one vote, either in person or by written proxy, at all meetings of the lot owners, for each lot so owned and maintained by such person.

Section Four

The annual meeting of the lot holders and members shall be held at the office of the Association in the Village of Herscher, or at such place as the Board of Directors may direct, on the first Tuesday of September of each year. The officers of the Association shall present at this meeting a full report of the condition of the Association which shall be spread upon the record of the Association.

Lot holders' meetings other than the annual meetings as herein provided may be held at such time as the Board of Directors may direct, or whenever eight lot holders may petition for it, and at such meetings any business lawfully brought before it may be transacted. Such special meetings shall be called by written or printed notice, mailed to a majority of the lot holders or by a notice published once in a newspaper of general circulation in

Section Five

The management of said Association shall be vested in a Board of Six Directors (Four of whom shall be a quorum for the transaction of business) who shall hold their office for six years; and until their successors are appointed and qualified, except the first Board appointed, three of whom shall hold their office for three years and three for six years. When the terms of the first Directors expire, the County Judge shall appoint all Directors thereafter. The County Judge shall also fill all vacancies caused by death or resignation of any of the Directors.

Section Six.

Immediately after the appointment of the first Board, and each succeeding year they shall organize by the election of one of their members as President, one as Vice President and one as Secretary and Treasurer, and may elect such other officers and committees as may be necessary to properly conduct the affairs of the Association.

Section Seven.

The President, Vice President, and Secretary and Treasurer shall perform such duties as are performed and required of such officers in similar Associations.

Board of Directors, in the performance of his duties.

Section Eight.

All improvements and repairs done in and about the Cemetery shall be made in accordance with and under the direction of the Board of Directors.

Section Nine

The price of Lots and the annual charge for the care of Lots and grounds and the charge of the Section for digging graves shall be fixed by a resolution of the Board of Directors and spread upon the records of the Association

Section Ten

These By-Laws may be amended or added to at any meeting of the lot holders, by a majority of the lots voting.
