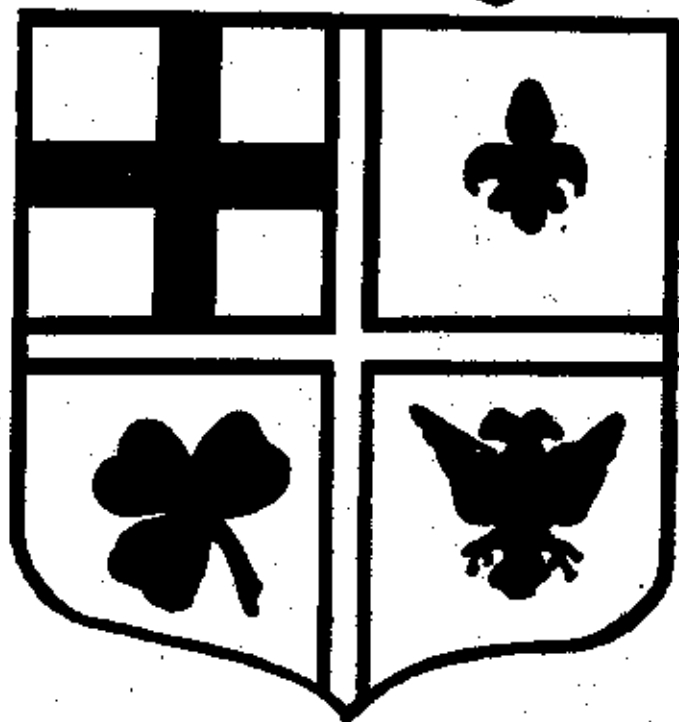

"UNREGISTERED GRAVES" ACT PASSED

In their final days of activity, the Illinois General Assembly passed the "Unregistered Graves Act" (House Bill 2613). This bill prohibits the disturbance of unregistered graves, markers, and human skeletal remains without a permit from the Illinois Historic Preservation Agency. The bill provides for criminal and civil penalties.

When signing the bill, Governor James R. Thompson said, "The question of who owns our past continues to be a subject of wide debate among philosophers, historians, genealogists, and native American groups in forums across the nation. To some, it is a question of philosophy or ethics. To others, the question is an intensely personal one, threatening family ancestry and heritage."

Thompson continued, "In Illinois, it is a question of Immediate concern to those who wish to halt 'mining' of field for artifacts and bones that bring increasing profits in open artifacts markets. This new law sets tough criminal and civil penalties for the intentional disturbance or desecration of unregistered graves - laws that should deter destruction of burial places of prehistoric Indians, pioneer settlers, and Civil War veterans."

In another bill (Senate Bill 467), penalties have been increased for vandals, thieves, and others who loot publicly owned archaeology and paleontology sites. The bill establishes a permit program administered by the Illinois Historic Preservation Society; it designates the State Museum as the official repository for artifacts from public lands; and protects archeological and paleontological resources at the local Government and University level.

Now state agencies will be required to submit plans for proposed projects to the IHPA, In order to determine if the project adversely affects an historic resource. Furthermore, the bill establishes procedures for examining project alternatives to help protect historic resources.

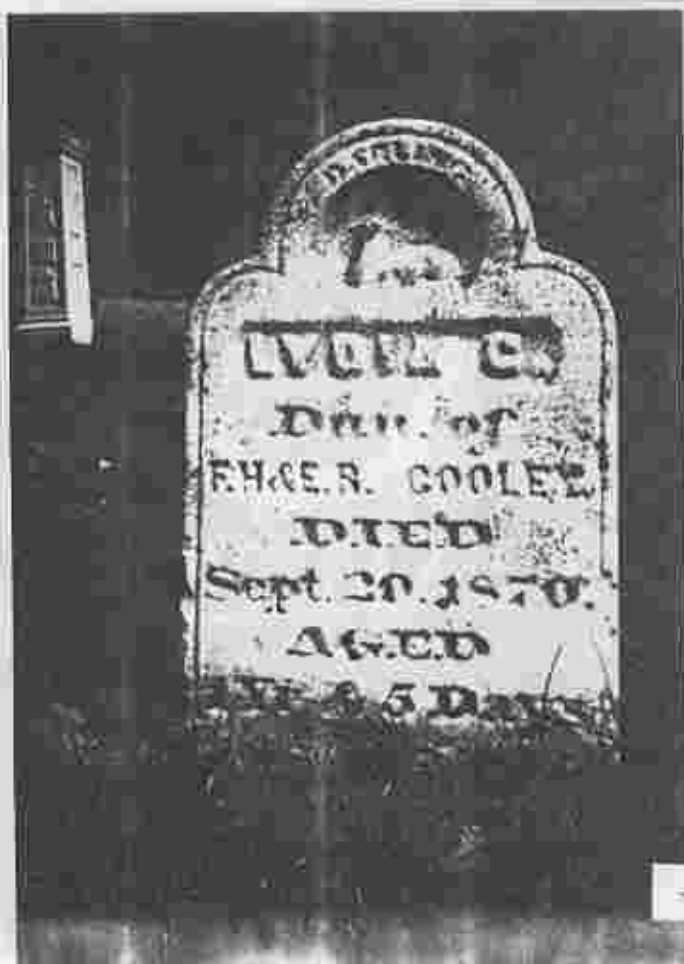

THE GEORGE LITTLE FAMILY ASSOCIATION

The George Little Family Association Is planning a 350th Anniversary Celebration in August, 1990. George Little settled In Newbury, Mass., in 1640. The farm he established is the oldest farm in the U.S. continuously cultivated by the same family and will be the site of the reunion. For information, write to the George Little Family Association, Stone Road, Hebron, IN 46341.

A genealogy prepared in 1882 by George Thomas Little, chronicles nearly 6,500 of George Little's descendants. 'The Descendants of George Little of Newbury, Mass.', is a remarkable 250 year record of one family during America's early history.

According to George Thomas Little's 1882 book, the family had representatives in each house of the National Congress, about one in every twenty family members had served in state legislatures and five members of the family had served as college presidents. At least three towns in the United States had been named Littleton after descendants of George Little (in New Hampshire, Pennsylvania and Colorado).

SYNOPSIS OF MEETINGS

September 9, 1989. Meeting

A notice was received from the LDS Church on Route 102 in Bourbonnais saying they had started a Family History Center. The center contains the 1988 IGI and hours are 10 to 2 p.m. Saturday and 6:30 to 7:30 p.m. Wednesday.

The dullest sale we ever saw was that of P. Duttonhaver's last week. There were but very few persons present. Uncle P. Osborne bought the buggy, which took us all by surprise. We asked Uncle P. to give us a ride, but he didn't seem inclined to do so. Uncle P. is getting "up" in the world.
