Settlement Patterns

If your ancestors settled in Kentucky just after the Revolutionary War, they may have had bounty lands from Virginia. Those who settled in Tennessee generally served from North Carolina. If your forbearers settled in Arkansas, Missouri or Illinois between 1816-1817 and initially held 80 or 160 acres, quite likely they served in the War of 1812. *Contra Costa Co. GS NL, Vol. 10 #9, Sept. 95.*

Missouri Tax Lists

Prior to the 1850's, purchasers of U.S. lands in Missouri were exempt from land taxes for five years after purchase. If you find your ancestor on a Missouri tax list with livestock, etc., but no land, he may have purchased his land from the U.S. within the five years preceding the tax list. But if he is paying tax on the land, you know he has been there longer than five years. *Bluegrass Roots, Vol. 20, No. 1.*

American Medical Association Records

The AMA no longer does research for physicians who died prior to 1969. They are currently working with the Genealogical Society of Utah and the National Genealogical Society to find a depository for these valuable records. British Census

Through an agreement between the Family History Department and the British Genealogical Record Users Committee, a cooperative project is underway to index the 1881 Census of England, Wales, Channel Islands, Isle of Mann and Scotland. This indexing project will create one of the most important resources for nineteenth century British research. Over thirty million name entries will be included. When all the county indexes have been completed, they will be combined into a single national index. Marking Photos

Have you ever wondered what to use to record information on the back of a photograph? One item frequently recommended by experts in the field is a Sharpie fine-point felt pen. This has the advantage of being permanent and will not damage the photograph. Ballpoint pens should be avoided at all costs. They are likely to leave impressions or dents on the face of your picture.

Pencils can also do this if they are not sharp enough. Pencil also has the disadvantage of rubbing off too easily. Most permanent markers will also bleed through after a time leaving blotches on your

pictures. One brand highly recommended by professional genealogists and conservators is the All Stabillo marker. Most art supply stores should carry either of these items. Be sure not to press too heavily, especially on older pictures to avoid dents or cracking the emulsion. *Twigs & Branches, North Central Illinois Gen. Society, March, 1996.*

1880 KANKAKEE COUNTY DEATHS

Taken from the Kankakee Gazette (publication date in parentheses).

(01 Apr 1880) The death of Mrs. Harriet A. Parker, of this city, last Monday morning was unexpected. She was stricken with that dread disease, pneumonia, exactly a week previously in the midst of her household duties, and has since been seriously ill; but she seemed more comfortable on the morning of her decease, and her immediate death was as unlooked for by her family as by her acquaintances. She awoke from a two hours' sleep, about nine o'clock, only to pass into a swoon in which she died. The funeral occurred yesterday afternoon at the family residence, Mr. Oggel

officiating. The deceased leaves a daughter and three sons to mourn the loss of their only parent. Mrs. Parker was the widow of the late Daniel S. Parker, at one time a member of the Illinois Legislature, and for many years editor and publisher of the Gazette, and postmaster of Kankakee. In 1873, after her husband's death, Mrs. Parker was appointed his successor in office and for four years served the people in that capacity. She was a woman of considerable business tact and by own efforts, together with the property left by her husband, she had a competency of this world's goods. She was a member of the Presbyterian church and her death will be a loss to that society, as well as regretted by a large circle of acquaintances.

(01 Apr 1880) Will H. Patterson, of Momence, died Saturday night of consumption, after a lingering illness. He was the last of the family bearing that name, several members having died within the past few years of the same insidious disease. His father, Wm. H. Patterson, Sr., died January 16, 1870, of typhoid fever, while representing Kankakee county in the constitutional convention. His sister, Mrs. Welt M. Durham, of Momence, is the last remaining member of the family. Will was universally esteemed for his genial disposition, and his death, at the age of 20 years, removes one from earth who promised to become a useful and honored citizen.

(01 Apr 1880) Miss Laura Chipman died at the residence of John E. Chipman, at Momence, on the 18th ult., aged 81 years and 7 months. "Aunt Laura" as she was called, was the last of seven brothers and sisters, all of whom lived to ages ranging from 57 to 90 years. The *Reporter* reveals the lady's romance as follows:

Aunt Laura, when young, was engaged to be married, but her betrothed husband died just previous to the day set for the marriage. At her request she was buried with her wedding ring on her finger.

(08 Apr 1880) In Kankakee, May 14, 1879, of pneumonia, Leoui E. N. Fortin, aged 1 year.

(15 Apr 1880) In Rockville, March 23, of typhoid pneumonia, George Warringer, aged 83 years.

(15 Apr 1880) In Yellowhead, March 10, Mrs. Lucy E. Pemble, aged 29 years.

(15 Apr 1880) In Yellowhead, April 4, of whooping cough and quick consumption, Cora J. Bartlett; aged 10 years.

(15 Apr 1880) In Omaha, on Thursday, April 8, of congestion of the lungs, Arthur, aged 19 months and 5 days, infant son of Hattie and Arthur R. Cummings.

(15 Apr 1880) At the residence of Asahel Warner, on the 3d inst., Mrs. Eliza Warner, aged 80 years. The deceased was the widow of the late Richard Warner, who resided on the west bank of the river a few years since.

(15 Apr 1880) Fred Larson, aged 30 years, living two and one-half miles northeast of Cabery, was taken sick one day last week while plowing. During the evening he vomited a large quantity of blood, and sank rapidly. The next evening he had a second attack of vomiting blood, and immediately died. He was conscious to the last. He leaves a bride of two months. The cause of his illness is not known. We are indebted to W. A. Colton for the foregoing facts.

(22 Apr 1880) At his residence in Grant Park, Thursday, April 8, Mr. Conrad Moose.

(29 Apr 1880) At Momence April 16, Mrs. Mary Mathews, relict of John Mathews, in the 83rd year of her age.

(29 Apr 1880) In this city, April 20, of consumption, Florence Nightengale Winter, aged 23 years.

The court has been largely engaged during the last week or so past with issuing final certificates of naturalization.

A. W. Ewing has opened up a meat shop in a building of his own.

A rather singular accident happened to John Brown (the Irishman) last week. While on the ground lifting a board to his man on a crib, he slipped and broke his angle bone. Dr. Caldwell is attending him.

Isaac D. Ayres has gone on a trip to Kansas and Nebraska for his health; will probably be gone all summer.

"Joe" Guyot is building another house to live in. This makes the third he has built and occupied within a year.

Henry Amidon while cutting hedge three weeks ago ran a thorn into his eye which left no mark nor drew blood; still he has been unable to use it since.

John Herscher has bought an eighty of land joining the village of Herscher belonging to Mrs. B. W. Cowles for \$35 per acre.

ROCKVILLE - 1880

Taken from the Kankakee Gazette, April 29, 1880.

We are sorry to note the death of "Bertie", one of Charley Durham's twins. The blow of "death's relentless hand" was a severe one on the bereaved family, and we are sure they have the sympathy of the entire community.

George Grimes is the inventor of a farm gate that is ahead of anything of the kind we have ever seen.

Geo. Goodwin, who has been canvassing for the last two weeks in the interest of Tudor & Goodwin, came home last Saturday sick with the measles. Henry T. Tudor and Benj. Goodwin, Sr., are now the proprietors of "Tudor's labor saving soap." Fred Mann, Jr., and W. H. Dawson are now on the road for the above named firm.

Joel A. Rouse is now one of the board of school directors in district No. 10.

Mrs. Benj. Goodwin has been at Chicago for a couple of weeks undergoing a surgical operation. She will be able to return home today, we learn.

Mrs. H. B. Durham is convalescent.

Obe Lancaster's boy, whose life was despaired of last week, is recovering very fast.

Bennie Goodwin, of Chicago, is at home on a short visit.

ESSEX - 1880

Taken from the Kankakee Gazette, April 1, 1880.

Jo Hauswirth has returned home again from Colorado. He doesn't speak very favorably of that country. Quite a number of cattle are starving. The people don't generally put up any hay for their stock and this has been a very hard winter; cold and plenty of snow.

Alonzo Colton and John Ferguson started for Colorado several weeks ago.

Mr. Daff's building is up at Norton. He intends to keep a restaurant. Tom

Shimmin, of Gardner, will put up a boot and shoe shop.

Robert Bradbeer, of Indiana, formerly of Essex, met with a fatal accident about two weeks ago. Mrs. B. was sick and Mr. B. hitched up his team and started for the doctor. His team ran away with him and broke his neck.

Miss Annie Palmer is on the sick list. She was trying to lift a tube of water to throw it out of the window. She tried it three times when something gave way inside. It is believed a blood vessel is busted.

H. Reigal is busily engaged building his new house; size 14 x 45, and 15 x 24.

Henry Wisemiller and Angeline Frost were united in marriage on the 24 ult. When the boys found it out they rattled 'em up lively. They will move on Mrs. Obrine's place. Pat Callehan and Miss Rose McAmaly were also joined in holy matrimony on the 30th ult. Well, that is just what we have expected. The boys started to play the cow-bells, etc., but Pat came out and told them to leave. They said Pat whipped them all out. Bully for Pat.

J. Oscha, who lived in L. C. Fuller's house last winter in Seenfield, ran away and left his wife. After an absence of about one week, he returned, hired out to Mr. Howland. His wife being sick, Mr. Osiers took her to his home in Essex (he had formerly adopted her.) Mr. O. came to see her, and then left for parts unknown. Mrs. O. died last Monday.

Peter Callehan, who has been on the sick list all winter, died on the 3d inst. His remains were interred in Joliet.

Alonzo Cotton writes from Denver, Col., and says it is very dry and dusty; feed very scarce. He says it takes six acres of pasture to feed one sheep and twenty acres for a cow.

Bill Clark has sold his coal shaft and fixtures to Levi McCormel and Mr. Marrow. Bill contemplates going west into the mining region.

Mr. Northrup and wife, of Michigan, will stop in Essex this summer.

Mr. W. Odell, of Braidwood, has bought out Mr. Londegan, who was buying grain in Essex. Mr. Odell has control of the whole business now.

Mr. Rankin is busily engaged in erecting his creamery in Essex.

D. J. White has his hardware store up; size, 29 x 36, 18 feet high. He intends to keep a general stock of hardware and farming implements.

Mr. Schremphf has put up a neat blacksmith and wagon shop and is now putting up a dwelling house.

Daniel B. Reid will put up a building for dwelling, restaurant, and boarding; size 16 x 30 and 16 x 18. Mr. Reid says he intends to make that his future habitation.

H. K. Wheeler last week made a purchase of the 120 acres left of the Perry Stratton farm on Section 18 of Yellowhead. Harris Wheeler brought sometime ago 160 acres of the same farm. The whole purchase amounted to the sum of \$7,450. This is good land and is situated about a mile north of Grant Park.

values, and the cost in the currency of the time exceeded \$30,000. Of this, over \$15,000 was raised by the efforts of Rev. Mr. Whitehead alone. There was, however, a large shrinkage in the subscriptions, but the debt of about \$8,000 was entirely subscribed on the fourth anniversary of the dedication, the first Sunday in June, 1870.

The pastorate of the Rev. J. M. Whitehead, which continued for six and one-half years, or until April, 1871, is always referred to with great commendation. The total additions to the membership in his time was three hundred and six, an average of nearly fifty per year. A man of kindly, genial nature, making friends everywhere, holding services out in schools and farm houses on the prairie, never ceasing his activity in his Master's cause, his work in Kankakee was in many ways remarkable. Not at all adapted to a cultured or educated congregation, he yet accomplished results at that period which few of the best educated in the land could have wrought.

Rev. B. F. Ashley, who succeeded him, was a scholarly gentleman who maintained his position but a year and a half, and was followed by Rev. A. C. Keene, whose pastorate also was short. In September, 1875, Rev. D. W. Dye became pastor and continued until his death May 30, 1882. Mr. Dye had been an officer in the Union army, and this was his first and only pastorate. He is recalled with much affection, not only by his own people, but by the community at large.

Following Mr. Dye were two vacancies, and two shore pastorates, that of Rev. L. L. Kneeland and Rev. J. B. Murch. August 1, 1887, Rev. W. L. Sanders became the pastor, continuing until May 30, 1896, nearly nine years, the longest thus far in the history of the church. He was a man who made many friends outside of his congregation and was, in great demand for addresses on all social occasions. Under him the church had a considerable increase in strength and membership.

Rev. W. A. Hyle, who remaining about two and a half years, was succeeded by Rev. W. R. Andereck, who continued in charge five years and a half, resigning April 1, 1905. During Rev. Mr. Andereck's pastorate, a lady member to whom the church is indebted for large gifts, and who had a loyal interest in all departments of Christian activity, gave the church a new Parsonage, which, with the land upon which it is built, is valued at \$7,000. Rev. Mr. Andereck was greatly respected in, the city, and held in

high esteem by the clergy of other denominations as a theologian, writer and pastor far above the average.

The present pastor is Rev. Charles Hazen, called to the pastorate in October, 1905.

The present membership of the church is two hundred and ninety-six, and of the Sunday school, two hundred and twenty. Contributions for all purposes for the year ending September, 1904, was \$3,328. The present value of the church property, including parsonage, is put at \$32,000.

GERMAN BAPTIST, KANKAKEE.

From 1858 to 1864, Rev. H. Jansen, of Monee, supplied the little band of Germans having Baptist affiliations at Kankakee, coming once or twice a month to preach to them in their fatherland tongue. In the latter part of '64 the society was organized, and a small chapel bought which had been built for a French mission under the auspices of the Protestant Episcopal church. It stood on the south-west corner of Schuyler avenue and Bourbonnais street, the location of the present church and parsonage. The Rev. T. Tschirch, a German gentleman of fine address and superior scholarship, was the first pastor, and the second was Rev. T. Techlenburg. The latter was succeeded by Rev. A. Transchel, who remained in charge for six years, and under whom, and his successor, Rev. C. Ohlgart, the membership and Sunday congregations were considerably, increased. Rev. H. Hilzinger was pastor from 1878-1883; Rev. F. Hoeflin, 1883-1887; Rev. A. Vogel, 1887-1891; Rev. G. Mengel, 1891-1901; Rev. William Ritzmann, 1901-1904; and Rev. J. Kaaz, 1904 to the present time.

In 1888 a substantial church was built on the old site, with a commodious basement, at a cost of \$6,000, and in 1902, an excellent parsonage was placed beside it on the west, taking the place of an old one removed, and costing \$4,000. The total value of the church property, including parsonage, is estimated at \$12,000, including corner lots, one hundred feet by one hundred and forty-five feet. The amount contributed for one year for all objects, according to the last report, was \$1,833. The present membership of the church is one hundred and sixty-two;

average attendance of Sunday school, seventy-eight; membership, one hundred and two.

SCANDINAVIAN BAPTIST, KANKAKEE

The membership of this small body is composed entirely of Danes, Swedes and Norwegians. The church was organized June 28, 1877. Rev. Nicholas Brink, for twenty-five years the pastor, besides his work here performed excellent service as a missionary among this class of foreign born people at different points in Indiana and Wisconsin. Rev. Mr. Brink died November 24, 1904, aged seventy-eight years. His successor, Rev. Mr. Hanson, residing elsewhere, comes for services every third week, but the old congregation has greatly diminished, and at present the membership is but twenty. The Sunday school has been closed, as children, readily learning the English tongue, become identified with other Christian bodies. The total value of the church property is about \$1,500, consisting of a small house of worship and the land upon which it is erected.

MOMENCE BAPTIST CHURCH.

This is the oldest Baptist church in Kankakee county. It is quite a strong body, but we have few facts not statistical. It was organized December 16, 1852, by Rev. Storrs, the names of whose eighteen successors have not been ascertained. The last in order and serving at the present time, is Rev. E. A. E. Palmquist, who supplies the data for this article. The first house of worship was built in 1852, with two hundred sittings, at a cost of \$2,000; the second, fifty years later, in 1902, with six hundred sittings, at a cost of \$15,000. The parsonage was built in 1880 for \$1,200. The present value of all church property is put at \$20,000. The total amount raised for all objects for one year, as given in the last official report, is \$3,000. The membership of the church, as stated in this report, is two hundred and six; and of the Sunday school two hundred and eighty-five, the latter's average attendance being one hundred and forty.

GRANT PARK BAPTIST CHURCH.

This is an off shoot of the Baptist church in Momence, the oldest in the county. It was organized February 26, 1875, by the following per-eons:

Mr. and Mrs. John Bennett, P. H. Burchard, R. Jaquish, O. W. Baker, John Strait, A. McWayne and Charles Snedecker, clerk. Rev. C. H. Rhodes, the first pastor, continued about a year; the second, Rev. A. R. Newton, remained four years; and the third was Rev. T. S. Dodge. From 1882 up to 1904 we have not been able to obtain data as to pastors or progress in church work. In 1882 the membership was reported at 47, while that of 1904 was one hundred and one, and Sunday school, sixty-two. The total value of church property is \$3,500; total amount contributed for all purposes for the year 1904, \$595. The present pastor is Rev. F. Woodhull.

ST. ANNE BAPTIST CHURCH.

This church was organized some time previous to 1860, but the exact date appears to be unknown. Rev. John Higby, the pastor at Momence, seems to have been chiefly instrumental in its establishment, and the first pastor was Rev. Louis Auger, who conducted services in the French language. The society languished from various causes until 1882, when a fresh impetus arose under the pastorate of Rev. Charles Chavez, who increased the membership to twenty-five. No further data is available until 1904, when the membership was reported eighty-five; the Sunday school, sixty, and total amount contributed for all church purposes was \$538. The value of church property over and above indebtedness is \$5,000. The present pastor is Rev. V. Robillard.

GERMAN LUTHERAN CHURCHES.

The German Lutherans have five churches in Kankakee county with about three thousand adherents and one thousand seven hundred, and ninety-one communicants. The first services in the county were held in the town of Pilot, from 1852 to 1857.

KANKAKEE.

The largest congregation is that of "S. Paul's Lutheran," in Kankakee, which was organized in 1860, and which, until the erection of the first church in 1864, was served by pastors from Pilot and elsewhere. The first church was a stone structure thirty-eight feet by fifty feet, standing on the corner of East avenue and Chestnut street. Though small, it was quite

sufficient for the needs of the little congregation. The first resident pastor was Rev. Carl Meyer, who remained from August, 1864, to August, 1870. Succeeding him up to 1883 was Rev. G. A. Mueller. In 1872 the old church was torn down and a frame structure built on its site, thirty-six feet by seventy-two feet, at a cost of \$7,000. This was burned in 1887, and property was purchased on the south-east corner of Merchant street and Dearborn avenue, one hundred and forty-five feet by one hundred and fifty feet, for the present commodious stone church and its accompanying parsonage, erected in 1888. Rev. Mr. Schroeder, the present efficient pastor, has held the office for twenty-one years. The communicant membership at the present time is six hundred and sixty-five. The congregations are large, especially on Sunday mornings, and the church is in a flourishing condition. A parochial school, conducted by several teachers and embracing one hundred and twelve pupils, has its home in the basement of the church. The value of the entire property is estimated at \$34,000.

PILOT.

The Lutheran church in this township was organized in 1859, and Rev. George Bernthal was its pastor from 1860 to 1862. The first church, built in 1861, cost \$700, and was twenty feet by thirty-four feet. A parsonage was built in 1877, and in 1882, the present church was built on the ilorth town line, Section 4, at a cost of \$3,000. A school home was built in 1882 with seats for sixty.

The present value of the property, including ten or twelve acres of land, is estimated at \$9,000. The communicants number 421.

GRANT PARK.

This congregation was organized in 1869, and the first church built in 1870, was destroyed by fire in 1880. Another was built the same year at a cost of \$3,000. The present communicant membership is two hundred and thirty-five. The value of the church property is estimated at \$5,000.

CHEBANSE.

The largest portion of this congregation live in Kankakee county and is therefore included in our sketches. The church was organized in 1895.

The present value of the church property is estimated at \$5,000. The number of communicants number two hundred and twenty-three.

SOLLIT.

The church here is large and flourishing, but we have received no data as to its organization, pastors, or date of building. The number of communicants is two hundred and forty-seven and the present value of the property is estimated at about \$9,000.

PROTESTANT EPISCOPAL.

S. Paul's Church, Kankakee.

After occasional services for several years by various mission clergymen, about thirty persons, in the spring of 1863, signed an application to the Rt. Rev. H. J. Whitehouse, then Bishop of the Diocese of Illinois, for his official sanction to the organization of an Episcopal church in Kankakee. Among these, and the leader in the movement, was William Sibley, who for twenty-five years thereafter was the senior warden of the parish. At a meeting held July 14, 1863, the parish was organized under the name of S. Paul's church, and the following officers were elected: Wardens, William Sibley and Benj. B. Beach; vestrymen, Emory Cobb, Alfred Daniels, James Sibley, W. H. Bristol, F. Eggleston, N. C. Terrill and F. G. Hutchinson. At a meeting of the vestry, held September 19, 1863, Rev. C. H. Albert was called as the first rector, and services began to be held regularly in Exchange hall, a room on the third floor of a block on the north-east corner of East avenue and Station street. Under the fostering care Of Rev. Albert the parish advanced and plans were made for building the first house of worship, which was completed and ready for use in the spring of 1865, having cost with the land about \$9,000. A considerable debt remained, however, which, under the rules of the Episcopal church, prevented the consecration of the building. After a prosperous pastorate of two and a half years Mr. Albert resigned, and Rev. William Rafter became rector for one year.

At a meeting of the vestry May 3, 1867, Rev. D. S. Phillips, of Bennington, Vermont, was called to the young church, his pastorate be-

ginning June 20, 1867, continuing until February 1, 1904, almost thirty-seven years. The debt of nearly \$3,000 was soon paid off, and the house of worship was consecrated by Bishop Whitehouse, June 9, 1869.

From 1868 to 1873 St. Paul's grammar school was maintained in connection with the regular work of the church under the general oversight of the rector, and chiefly sustained by the liberality of Mr. Emory Cobb; also the largest contributor to the support of the church during its entire history up to the present time. During the five years of its existence about four hundred different pupils were enrolled in this school.

For over thirty years the Sunday school of the church was one of its prominent features, having a membership ranging from one hundred and seventy-five to two hundred and twenty-five, for several years next to the largest in the city. Its anniversaries or "Harvest Homes" were continued annually for twenty-nine years, and, with its Christmas and Easter song services, were always occasions of much enthusiasm, drawing a large attendance of adults as well as children. Over one-half of the additions to the church by baptism or confirmation during this long pastorate came from the Sunday school.

The church interested itself to some extent in neighboring missionary work. At Chebanse, services were held with more or less regularity for five years, and at Waldron for two years. The most successful effort, however, was at Momence, the present Church of the Good Shepherd, at that place, being a direct offspring of St. Paul's, Kankakee.

The year 1892 was made notable by the twenty-fifth anniversary of the pastor. The assemblies were enthusiastic, and that there was a general interest in the long pastorate may be inferred from the fact that a gift of \$2,500 was presented to the rector from his people, \$100 for each year of service. The same year the degree of Doctor of Divinity was conferred upon the pastor by Racine college.

In 1898 the question of building a new church began to be agitated. The old church lot, on the south-east corner of Schuyler avenue and Merchant street, was sold in March, 1899, for \$10,000 and another purchased near the public library and high school buildings on the north-east corner of Harrison avenue and Station street. The present beautiful edifies was completed in

September, 1900. Its entire cost including the land, furnishings and various memorials; such as the organ at 42,500 from Mrs. Helen Huling, aggregated about \$32,000. Bequests amounting to \$6,700, memorial gifts of about \$3,500, and proceeds from the sale of the old church lot, greatly aided in paying for the new property. Since the completion of the church, \$5,000 has been received through the will of Hon. H. C. Clarke, for many years a beloved officer of the parish; and an equal sum by the will of Mrs. Helen Huling, both being designated by the donors as endowments for support of the church music.

At the beginning of Rev. Dr. Phillips' pastorate the number of communicants was forty-one. The total number of baptisms in the thirty-seven years was eight hundred and thirty; the total confirmations, six hundred and forty-seven; the total communicants at the end of his pastorate was two hundred and fifty-one. Like nearly all Episcopal churches in the smaller cities of the middle west. St. Paul's lost far more by removals hence than it gained by removals hither. Only eight of the original communicants found by him were left when Dr. Phillips' pastorate ended. Of the vestry that called him to the parish but one remained, Mr. Emory Cobb, the present senior warden, who from the beginning has been a leading layman of the diocese as well as of the parish.

Dr. Phillips was made Rector Emeritus on his resignation, and a generous annuity voted by the vestry. He continues to reside in the parish, but has no official connection therewith, his work having to do almost entirely with the church at large in the Diocese of Chicago. No vacancy occurred after his resignation, Rev. H. A. Chouinard at once taking up the work February 1, 1904, continuing it in a manner most acceptable to his charge. In the short period of his rectorate important measures have been set on foot and vigorously sustained. The music has been improved, a large men's club has been organized, and a rectory built at an estimated cost of \$6,300. Land was purchased for this purpose adjoining the north side of the church, increasing the original lot to one hundred and forty-five feet by one hundred and thirty feet, The total value of the church property is now estimated at about \$40,000, which, however, there is some indebtedness.

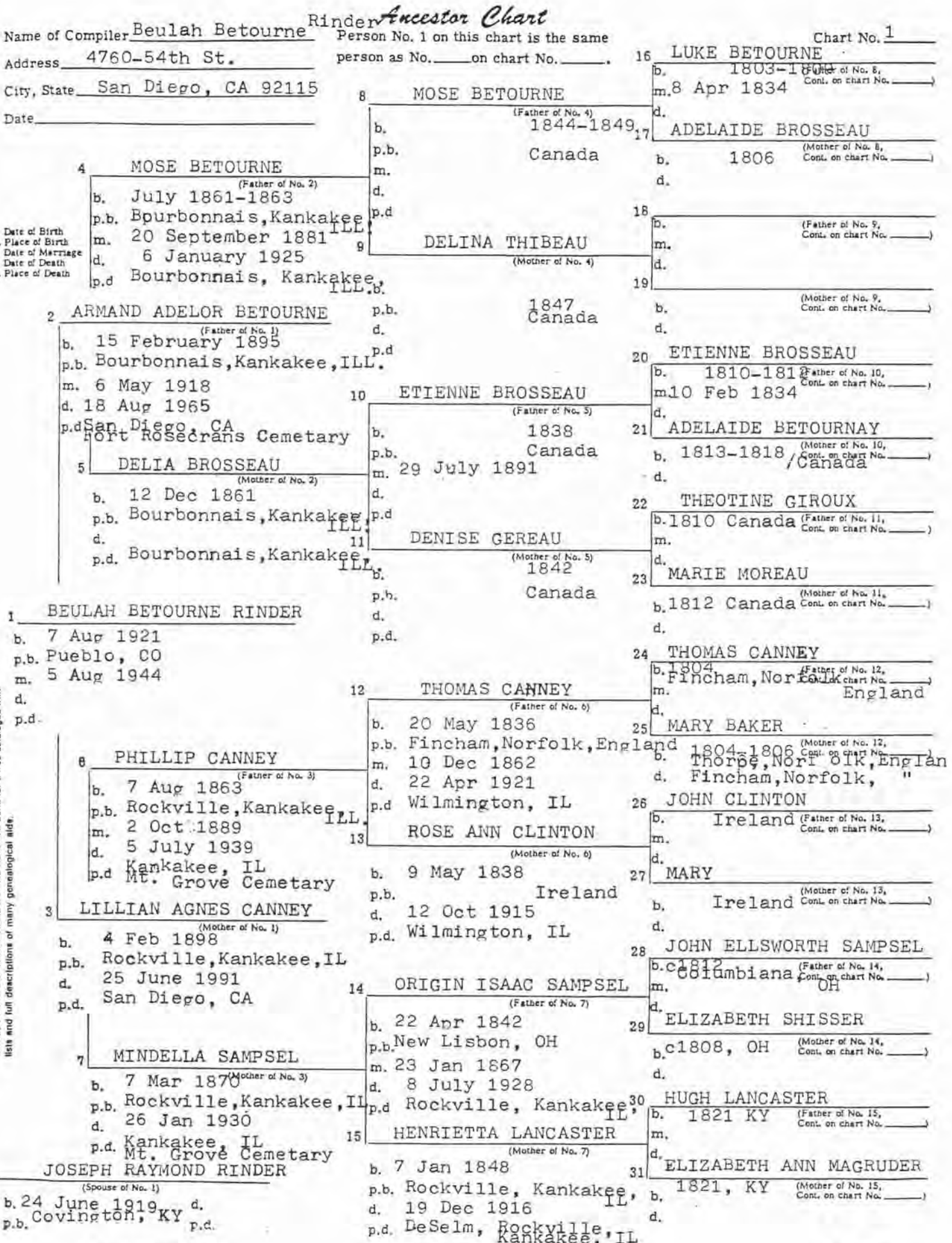
